

Swing Frame(s) - Assembly



Gaps = 6mm

However designed for 4mm boards

Step 1 = Wall Bracket (Bottom)

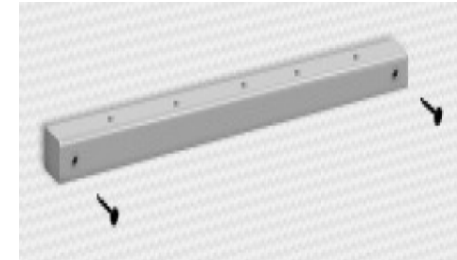
1. Starting at the base, present the lower bracket to your wall
2. The Bottom Bracket - does not have holes all the way through!
3. Using a spirit level and a pencil, mark the holding holes to your wall
4. Remove bracket + drill holes + add raw plugs
5. Secure bracket to the wall using screws - Step 1 is now completed

Step 2 - Wall Bracket (Top)

1. Using one of the sleeve frames & with the help of an assistant
2. Plumb the wall, calculate the top height & mark with a pencil
3. Important - Leave a slight gap between both brackets - see Step 3
4. Pick up the Second Wall Bracket + Wooden Frame
5. Now insert Swing Frame. Into the bottom bracket 1st hole....
6. Now, insert top of the swing frame in the 1st bracket hole
7. Pencil mark the correct position of the top bracket
8. Now, level the bracket, mark the holes + drill + raw plug + screws

Step 3 - Inserting the Sleeve Frame into Brackets

- 1 - At this point you should have 2x Brackets attached to your wall
- 2 - Pick up the 1st Frame + Connecting Rod
- 3a - Insert the Rod into the 1st top bracket hole
- 3a - Insert the Rod through both swing arms
- 3c - Insert the Rod in to 1st bottom bracket hole
- 4 - Now repeat steps 3a, 3b, 3c for remaining Frames
- 5 - Documents are covered on - Page 2

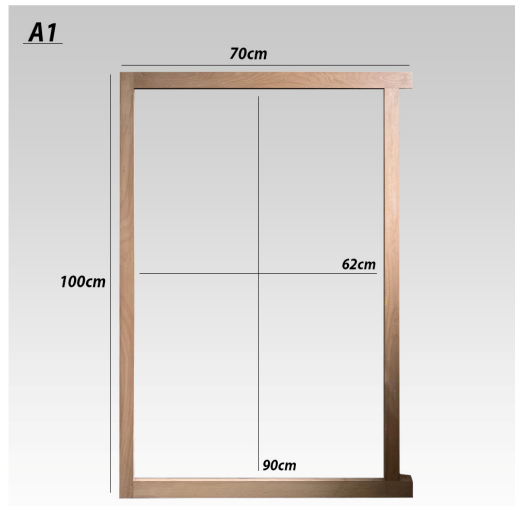


3x Swing Frame (Sizes)**A1 - Swing Frame (Sizes)**

Height = 100cm (1000mm)

Width = 70cm (700mm)

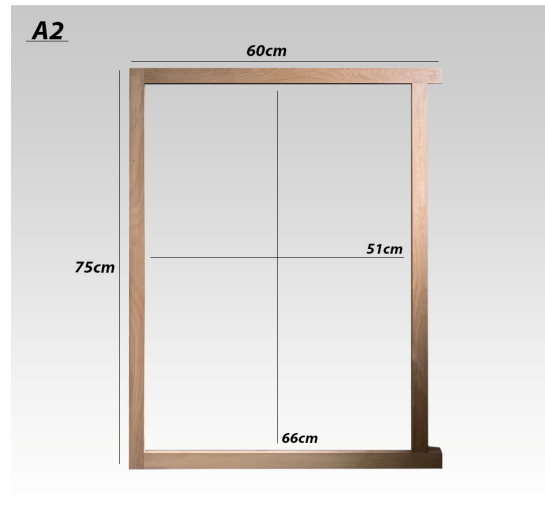
Internal = 90cm (900mm) x 62cm (620mm)

**A2 - Swing Frame (Sizes)**

Height = 75cm (750mm)

Width = 60cm (600mm)

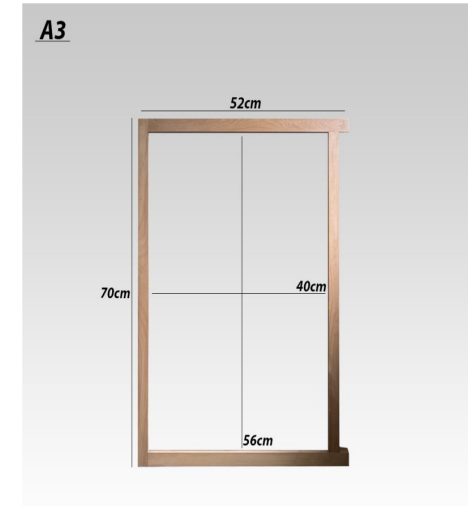
Internal = 66cm (660mm) x 51cm (510mm)

**A3 - Swing Frame (Sizes)**

Height = 70cm (700mm)

Width = 52cm (520mm)

Internal = 54cm (540mm) x 40cm (400mm)

**Documents:**

- 1 Each Swing Frame is designed to add - either A1 - A2 - A3 Portrait Documents (2x Documents per Swing Frame) + all re-usable as documents need changing
- 2 Remove the 1x Foam Panel + 2x PVC Sheets, now sandwich your documents - then, re-insert into the Swing Frame (takes seconds)
- 3 **TIP** - If you plan to add several 'Photographs' - it may prove wise to utilise 'Blue-Tack' to each photo, to prevent them dropping to the bottom of the display
